




OFFICER REACTIONS


Examining the responses to each individual question shows further approval and student support.





The goals and objectives of the course were explained in a clearly defined manner.





The course material was interrelated to the actual job of a police officer. An adequate number of effective examples were utilized to illustrate this relationship.





Multiple methods of presentation were used to convey the course material. The use of various training aids enhanced the effectiveness of the presentations.






